



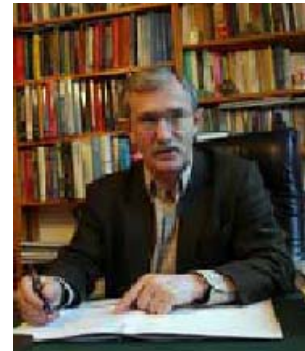

His research interests include macroeconomic theory, economic policy, systemic transformation in East Central Europe, privatization, public finance, economic growth and real convergence.
