Short description of the professional and teaching experience including research interests

Roland Doll is Executive Vice President International Government Relations in the Group Headquarters of Deutsche Telekom. 1997 he joined Deutsche Telekom as Assistant Director for Government Relations and Regulatory Affairs. In 2000 he was appointed Vice President International Regulatory Affairs at Deutsche Telekom.

Roland Doll studied law at Universities of Frankfurt and Lausanne. After the second state examination in law he did post-graduate studies in international commercial law at the University of Aberdeen. He had appointments as assistant professor at University of Frankfurt and as researcher in telecommunications law and regulation.
